

Kadar Penghidap Autisma Meningkat

IPOH: Sekiranya anak anda tidak boleh bercakap sekurang-kurangnya enam patah perkataan ketika berumur 18 bulan, jangan tunggu lagi, berjumpalah segera dengan pakar pediatrik.

Anak anda mungkin mengidap autisma dan rawatan awal boleh membantunya menjalani kehidupan seperti kanak-kanak lain.



Menurut Ketua Jabatan Pediatrik Hospital Raja Permaisuri Bainun (HRPB), Datuk Dr Amar Singh, kadar pengidap autisma di negara ini meningkat 1/100 berbanding 1/500 kira-kira 10 tahun lalu.

“Kita tidak tahu apakah punca sebenar autisma tetapi rawatan awal boleh membantu memulihkan antara 50 – 70 peratus daripada mereka,” katanya pada sidang media di Kelab Ipoh Diraja di sini pada Jumaat.

Sidang media itu untuk memaklumkan mengenai penganjuran Forum Awam Rotary mengenai autisma anjuran bersama Jabatan Pediatrik HRPB dan lima Kelab Rotary di Ipoh – Kelab Rotary Ipoh Selatan, Kelab Rotary Greentown, Kelab Rotary Ipoh, Kelab Rotary Metro Ipoh dan Kelab Rotary Kinta.

Forum turut disokong oleh beberapa agensi serta organisasi bukan kerajaan (NGO) seperti Kementerian Pendidikan, Persatuan Pediatrik Malaysia, MySihat, National Early Childhood Intervention Council, Network for the Needs of Children with Disabilities (Perak), Persatuan Ohana Perak dan Persatuan Kebangsaan Austisme Malaysia.
